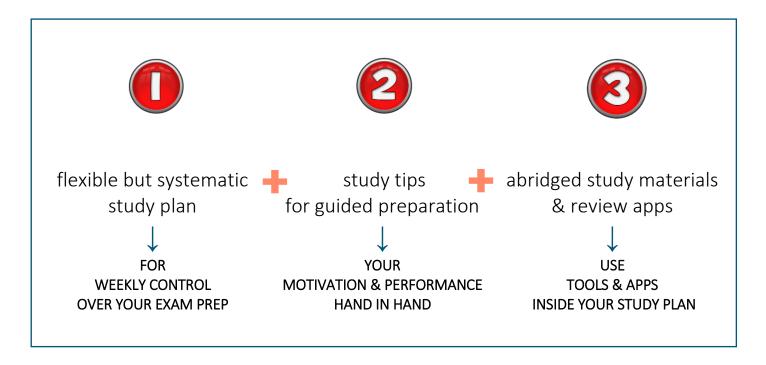

Learn What You Study

- Choose a **study plan** that easily adapts to what happens daily while still keeping you accountable.
- Allow for 300 hours, which is the average study time you need to spend preparing for your level 1 CFA exam if you want to succeed.
- Adopt a WEEK-to-WEEK attitude that ensures you stay in control even with some bad study weeks along the way.

- Keep your motivation simmer. It won't be 100 degrees Celsius all the time but you can't let it cool.
- Develop good study habits: weekly apply the strategy of *PLAN STUDY REVIEW ASSESS* to get yourself going.
- Remember: numbers don't lie if you get too many overdue readings or too few study hours done your chance to pass naturally decreases.
- Use various study materials & tools to aid your knowledge retention and get enough practice.
- Review after you study to help your learning curve grow. Topic **review** or final review are fine but may be not enough to overcome your forgetting!
- Never stop learning how to learn. *GROWTH* in this aspect leads straight to success!

3 PILLARS OF YOUR CFA EXAM PREP:

Control

You get all your CFA exam readings assigned to your study weeks. Each week can be edited if needed — preferably at the very start. Over the week — as you study — you can mark your readings as done or partially done to watch your daily progress. When the week ends — sum it up and see how you did. Is your Chance-to-Pass score up or down compared to your previous week?

Motivation

If you do your weekly readings and summarize each study week – your Chance-to-Pass will grow. To stay motivated to study – you will receive motivational messages with study tips aimed at building your study routine. For the purpose of good performance – you will get study times estimated for each reading. This will naturally tell you how many study hours you need per week (always adjusted for your edition changes).

Knowledge Retention

Ideally, you should use your CFA exam curriculum first and then our resources or, e.g., Schweser study materials to revise and retain required study content.
